Milan, the capital of fashion

Arrive at Milan Malpensa airport and travel to Milan City Center via private transfer.

Here you will check in at your hotel in the heart of the city, placing you and your companions right at the crossroads of culture, fashion, and design.

Welcome drinks and a light dinner will be given on the hotel premises. Finally, a brief description of the tour will follow, given by your Elesta expert guide.







Milan, the capital of fashion

After breakfast, you will meet your personal guide for your introduction to Milan. As you walk its streets and neighborhoods, you will uncover how its design and structure reflect its cultural and political history, from the Roman ruins still standing in the city center to the Spanish walls built after centuries of expansion. Take in the architectural wonder of **Teatro alla Scala**, **the Duomo**, **the Galleria Vittorio Emanuele**, and we will, of course, stop for an espresso or another refreshing drink in one of Milan's historic cafes or bars.

As the grand finale to your first Milanese day, you will visit Leonardo DaVinci's masterpiece, *The Last Supper*.

Zona Tortona

Today you will visit the **Armani Silos Museum**, a 19th century granary now transformed into a stunning archive of fashion. You will also explore **Zona Tortona**, home of **Milan Design Week**. After a visit to the **La Scala Costumes Atelier**, we will walk back to the **Navigli** area for lunch.

Set on two canals, it is the ideal setting in which to better understand the vital commercial connections between the city and its surroundings. At one time the narrow river for which the **Navigli** is named was a key trade route. Milan's connections with the Alps, France, and Switzerland are all part of the history that has made the city so vibrant and prosperous.

The rest of your afternoon and your dinner will follow at your leisure.



Lake Como in Fashion

After lunch, travel via private transport to the beautiful Lake Como.

Here, in the 15th century, Ludovico Il Moro, the Duke of Milan, invited the inhabitants of **Lago di Como** to plant mulberry trees in their gardens so they could grow silkworms. The Milanese silk industry has flourished ever since.

Discover the secrets and artistry of textile creation in a place that, since 1985, has been dedicated to the study of its cultural, technological and design heritage: the esteemed **Fondazione Ratti.**

Antonio Ratti established his foundation as a means to transform his passion for art and textiles into an actionable initiative. In this way, he could give back to the city that had inspired him and so many others.

Enjoy a free afternoon to explore the area at your leisure.

The day ends with *aperitivi* and dinner in Como, overlooking the lake.



Deep dive into italian brands

Let's meet the big ones! We will accompany you to the most famous brands in the world.

Walk along **Via Montenapoleone** and **Via della Spiga** to meet representatives from **Armani**, **Prada**, **Dolce e Gabbana** among others. This is where the most renowned Italian brands display their new collections. We will visit the original **Prada** store, established in 1919.

All this is 'Made in Italy' at its best. Even the shop windows hold magic: the displays are pure art. No wonder Italy is renowned as the place to study the art of window dressing.

In the afternoon, you will continue exploring at your leisure. Elesta is available to arrange optional visits to the futuristic galleries of the **Fondazione Prada** or to offer other suggestions for pursuing your fashion and artistic dreams.

After a group lunch in **Brera**, known as Milan's artists' quarter, you are free to explore the galleries, artisan boutiques, and many vintage shops in one of the coolest parts of the city. Your guide is eager to provide you recommendations tailored to your interests.

Dinner follows at your leisure.
